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Mission Statement:

The mission of Orange Presbyterian Weekday School (OPWS) is to provide an atmosphere where children will grow academically, physically, spiritually, and socially. This philosophy is modeled after how Jesus grew in Luke 2:52 - "Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man." Promoting devotion to Christian principles is at the heart of our program and we believe that children learn best through play to achieve growth in all areas.

Philosophy:

The Orange Presbyterian Weekday School is sponsored by the Orange Presbyterian Church. The Weekday School is a ministry of the church and represents the church through its work. It is the church's desire that OPWS promote a devotion to Christian principles and beliefs and fosters faith.

Christian Emphasis:

The Presbyterian Weekday School has been a ministry of the Orange Presbyterian Church for over forty years. We hope to spread the love of Jesus with the children through daily prayers at snack time and a weekly Bible lesson.

Staff Requirements:

Requirements for OPWS Staff include:

- Annual health check performed by a licensed physician.
- Criminal background and central registry check.
- CPR/First Aid Certified (at least two)

Our Facility:

Orange Presbyterian Weekday School is located on the lower level of Orange Presbyterian Church.

Enrollment Capacity:

Our enrollment capacity is 42 students. Staff to child ratio is 1:6.

Public Liability Insurance:

Orange Presbyterian Weekday school is covered under Orange Presbyterian Church's liability insurance Policy.

Religiously Exempt Child Day Center:

Orange Presbyterian Weekday School is a Religiously Exempt Child Day Center (RECDC) under the regulations mandated by the Virginia Department of Education.

Tuition

Three-Year Old Program: \$150.00/month Four-Year Old Program: \$175.00/month

Tuition payments are due on the first of the month. A \$10.00 late fee will be applied to payments received after the fifth of the month. Accounts overdue by more than one month will result in suspension until the account is paid up to date. Please visit our website to set-up electronic payments or make checks payable to: Orange Presbyterian Weekday School or OPWS. In the memo section write the child's name and month.

School Hours:

Students may be dropped off beginning at 8:50 am and school concludes at 12:00 noon.

Clothing:

Please dress your child comfortably in clothing and shoes that can stand the wear and tear of crawling, climbing, painting, and other messy activities. Additionally, we ask that you keep a complete change of clothes in your child's bag in the event of an accident or spill.

Mid-Morning Snack:

We serve a healthy snack each day. Families are welcome to send in a special treat (cookies, donut holes, or mini-cupcakes) for birthdays. Children should not bring any candy, gum (nor should it be in their mouths when they come in), or extra treats to school. Please alert the staff if your child has any dietary restrictions or food allergies.

Field Trips:

We will occasionally take walking field trips in the town of Orange. Additionally, we will take seasonal field trips such as to Sarah's Pumpkin Patch in the Fall.

Health:

OPWS will make every effort to protect the health and safety of the children. The cooperation of parents in helping prevent the spread of communicable diseases is of great importance. We adhere to the requirements of the Virginia Department of Education including a current School Entrance Health Form.

If your child has a fever (100.4 or higher) or any contagious illness (such as pink eye), the student must stay home for a minimum of 24-hours. Staff will make daily health observations of each child. Should your child become ill during the morning, we will call you. Our staff will not administer any medication except an Epi-Pen.

Any time throughout the year that there is a change in your home, work, or childcare provider's phone number, please let us know. Notify OPWS if your child becomes ill with any contagious or self-spreading illness (flu, head lice, strep throat, etc.), or if your child will be absent.

Parent-Teacher Conferences:

Prior to public school kindergarten registration, Parent-Teacher Conferences will be held for the 4-year old class to discuss your child's readiness. Conferences for the 3-year old class can be arranged whenever the need arises.

Transportation:

Parents and/or caregivers are responsible for the transportation of children. Please inform OPWS if any changes are made to your transportation plan, or if someone different will be picking up your child. For parents who will be bringing their children to school for the first time, we understand that the excitement of this new beginning is tinged with some anxiety and reservation. Some children may display various emotions until they begin to feel secure in their new surroundings. You can help by bringing your child with a cheerful, positive attitude. Children move into classrooms for snack followed by small group learning, art, math, and/or science.
