## A letter from Pastor Rebekah



Friends,

In years past, it has been the norm that summer is a time of dormancy for the life of the church. Sunday School is over for the year, families travel, so worship attendance is down, services tend to be more casual. If this were a 'normal' year, that is what would be in our immediate future. But, as we all know, we are in the midst of getting to know our new normal. After over a year of erring on the side of caution, social distancing, and not meeting in person for worship, it seems that we are now at a time we feel comfortable revving back up.

I have loved worshipping together over the past month. I understand and respect everyone's decisions, to come or to stay home. We are doing our best to meet all of these needs. It is far from perfect, but my hope is that whether you come in person, or join in worshipping virtually, you feel the presence of the Holy Spirit and the love of the community.

At this time we feel like we can continue to worship in person on Sunday mornings, and we will continue to offer online options. We will also be doing a book study over the summer.
